- In order to:
  - Increase participation and adoption
  - Clarify and tighten the Governance of activities, in particular, specification development, and operations
  - Empower the community to make decisions in day to day operations for OSLC adoption
  - Enable Standardization of final specs, including the transfer of IP
- We plan to:
  - Create a Steering Committee to bring others into the decision-making process
  - Implement this with changes to the web site terms of use, new members agreement and new workgroup participation agreement (WPA)








#### **OSLC Community Governance Roadmap**

# **OSLC Steering Committee Details**


<ul> <li>High-level decision making body to focus on Business and Operational issues</li> <li>Operational</li> <li>Approves work group creation, decommission, and scope changes</li> <li>Approves final specs (after work group approves)</li> <li>Approves Target Standards organizations for specifications</li> <li>Provides guidance on Governance Updates (Members Agreement, OSLC terms of use, Operational Documents)</li> <li>Business</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Membership</li> <li>Members will be entities</li> <li>Only one formal position - chair</li> <li>IBM is the founding chair</li> <li>Size: Initially 5 to 7 members from the community</li> <li>Initially 2-year terms, 1 year terms after the initial term</li> <li>Founding members will be selected based community leadership</li> <li>Next round of Steering Committee members elected by OSLC Members</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Helps recruit and develop other business alliances</li> <li>Coordinates Communications</li> </ul>	Voting process <ul> <li>Each Organization gets only 1 vote</li> <li>Community review prior to vote</li> <li>2/3 majority to pass</li> </ul>

#### Workflow of the new OSLC governance model





## Rollout

- Engage, Recruit Steering Committee leads and gain feedback on the proposal (April)
- Develop the new infrastructure to support the governance model (end of May)
- Socialize the plan and agreement with OSLC community (early May)
- Finalize members agreement (mid May)
- Distribute the draft agreements to the community for review (mid May)
- New OSLC infrastructure goes live (early June)
- All specification authors must have signed members' agreement (end of June)
- Complete inaugural F2F Steering Committee agenda (end of May)
- F2F meeting for the Steering Committee at Innovate (First week of June)
